Greetings.....

We are pleased to inform you regarding the resumption of our Moscow-Delhi-Moscow operations in accordance with the “bilateral air bubble agreement” between Russia and India **effective 12<sup>th</sup> February 2021**.

The flights would operate under the air bubble till the resumption of scheduled international flights to/from India. Below is the schedule for your reference (updated in the GDS) –

Following passengers will be carried between India and Russia –

**INBOUND FLIGHTS INTO INDIA –**

On flights to Delhi, the following categories of passengers are accepted for transportation-

- citizens of India, Nepal and Bhutan;
- foreign citizens - holders of OSI and PIO cards (confirming Indian origin);
- citizens of the Russian Federation - holders of all types of visas, with the exception of tourist;
- sailors - citizens of the Russian Federation, traveling in order to change crews.

All passengers arriving in India must have a printed medical certificate with a negative COVID-19 (RT-PCR) test taken

no earlier than 72 hours before the flight departs from the original departure point.

In the absence of a test result for COVID-19 or expiration of the validity period, the passenger can be tested upon

arrival at Delhi airport and stay in a special area until the results are received.

**OUTBOUND FLIGHTS FROM INDIA –**

The following categories of passengers are accepted for transportation on flights to Moscow:

- citizens of the Russian Federation;
- Indian citizens - holders of all types of valid visas;

- foreign citizens holding a residence permit or other document confirming the right to permanently reside in India, subject to the presentation of valid identity documents and visas, or in a visa-free manner in cases provided for by international treaties of the Russian Federation;
- sailors - citizens of India, traveling in order to change crews;
- as well as other categories of foreign citizens

Traffic carried to/from India shall comprise of passengers originating from/destined for Russia and vice versa.
