## **Germany restricts entry from areas with virus variants**

**Dear Traveler,**

Due to requirements of the German Federal Police, passengers from virus variant areas are subject to extended travel conditions starting 30 January 2021.

**Airlines are currently only permitted** to carry the following passengers **to or via Germany on departures from countries classified as virus variant areas** (Brazil, Ireland, South Africa, Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Portugal, Eswatini and Lesotho\*) until at least 17 February 2021:

- Passengers with German nationality or passengers with a valid residence permit in Germany (upon presentation of a German registration certificate)
- Passengers of other nationalities if they have a connecting flight to a "Non-Schengen country" and do not leave the

transit area in Frankfurt or Munich (Exception: flights from Portugal on which no passengers of other nationalities with connecting flights to Schengen- or Non-Schengen countries are permitted)

- All passengers must present a negative test result (PCR, antigen, RT-LAMP or TMA), which is not older than 48 hours before the scheduled time of entry in Germany, and complete the [Digital Entry Registration](#)
- All passengers with a final destination in Germany must follow the local German quarantine regulations
- All passengers with a connecting flight to a destination outside Germany must also observe the entry regulations of the corresponding destination country
