New Dubai arrival requirements *280121

Dear Trade Partner,

Please be informed on the new Dubai arrival requirements effective 31 January 2021.

All passengers arriving into Dubai from any point of origin (GCC countries included) must hold a negative polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test certificate, for which the test must be taken **no more than 72 hours** prior to time of departure.

The certificate must be for a polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test. Other test certificates including antibody tests and home testing kits are not accepted in Dubai.

You must bring an official, printed certificate in English or Arabic to check in – SMS and digital certificates are not accepted

UAE nationals are exempt from the above, however they will be required to take a PCR test on arrival at DXB.

Passengers arriving into DXB from certain countries (click here to check [list of countries](#)) will be required to take another PCR test on arrival at DXB.
