1. Stay-Home Notice (SHN) and COVID-19 Test Requirements

Hong Kong

The Hong Kong government has boarding and compulsory quarantine requirements for travellers from different places. For more information, please click [here](#).

From 23 January 2021, 00.00am SGT, all persons who have stayed in Brazil or Ireland for more than two hours in the 21 days prior to departure will not be allowed to board flights for Hong Kong.

Australia

From 22 January 2021 (local time at departure point), all passengers over the age of 5 years old, travelling to or transiting through Australia, must also provide a negative COVID-19 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test result, taken within 72 hours before their flight.
