Passengers from Macao SAR will serve a 7-day SHN at their place of residence. The COVID-19 test will continue to be administered before the end of the 7-day SHN.

All other passengers from other countries must serve their 14-day SHN at dedicated SHN facilities, and will be subjected to COVID-19 test before the end of the SHN.

Passengers from Fiji, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Hong Kong SAR and Vietnam may apply to opt out of dedicated SHN facilities and serve their 14-day SHN at their place of residence.

3. Singapore **Pre-departure** COVID-19 test (PDT) Depending on passenger's travel history and Safe Travel Lane used to visit Singapore, passengers may be required to take a pre-departure COVID-19 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) within 72 test hours before their flight.

The pre-departure COVID-19 test does not apply to:

• Singapore Citizens and Permanent Residents (PR)

- Children aged 6 and below (based on calendar year)
- Passengers who have remained in the following places for the past 14 days:

*With effect from 12 February 2021, 2359 hours (GMT+8), passengers who are not Singapore Citizens or PRs will need to take a COVID-19 PCR test within 72 hours before departure.

- Pre-approved Business Pass Holders issued by the Ministry of Trade and Industry • (MTI)

The pre-departure test requirement will apply in addition to other existing requirements such as having to obtain an Approval Letter of Entry, Stay-Home Notice (SHN) and having take а COVID-19 test before the end of their SHN. to

2 pieces of cabin baggage with combined weight not exceeding 10kg (Economy) and 15kg (ScootPlus) are allowed. The larger piece must not exceed 54cm x 38cm x 23cm (total linear dimensions cannot exceed 115cm) and must fit into the overhead compartment. The smaller piece must not exceed 40cm x 30cm x 10cm and must be able to fit under the seat in front of the passenger. Please click here for
