



# Notice on the Adjusting Requirements for China-Bound Passengers from India

This is to inform you that the Embassy of China in India has adjusted the Requirements for China-Bound Passengers from India. Starting from 8 January 2023, COVID-19 will be managed as a Class B infectious disease in China, and border control measures will be adjusted accordingly. China-bound passengers are advised to read the following information on the adjustment to facilitate traveling:

## I. Nucleic Acid Test

Passengers are required to take nucleic acid test within 48 hours before flight arrival into China, and can only take flight when the test result is negative.

### II. Health Code

Passengers are no longer required to obtain health code from the Chinese Embassy or Consulates General in India before departure.

### III. Health Declaration to China Customs

Passengers need to declare the negative test result to China Customs by filling the Health Declaration Form either on Wechat mini-program of China Customs (scan the QR code below), or at the web page

(https://htdecl.chinaport.gov.cn/htdeclweb/home/pages/healthDeclare/declare.html), or via the China Customs APP.

# IV. Entry Inspection

There will be no nucleic acid test when passengers enter China, and no quarantine for those whose health declaration and entry inspection produce normal results. In case of a positive test result or any symptoms such as fever detected by China Customs, passengers will take an antigen test. Those who test positive will need to self-quarantine.
