



MALDIVES: Positive Recovered Travel Approvals

Dated: 22nd December, 2021

Dear All,

Greetings from Sri Lankan Airlines !!!

All travellers must have a valid negative PCR test result obtained at least 96 hours prior to the first port of embarkation en-route to the Maldives. Children below the age of 1 (one) year are exempted. However, if a positive recovered case is unable to get a negative PCR within 60 days of their positive sample collection, the traveller can obtain a travel approval from the Health Protection Agency.

The proof of COVID-19 infection or recovery should be with the following information in English:

1. Full Name (as on travel document)
2. Passport Number
3. Date of Birth
4. Nationality (as on travel document)
5. Sample Collection Date • Document Issued Date
6. Travel Date
7. Flight Number

COVID-19 recovery passes that are issued by government health authorities are also accepted with the above additional information.

Please note that COVID-19 recovery from a sample collected no more than 60 days does not exempt travellers from submitting the mandated pre-departure COVID-19 PCR test.

All travellers must submit the pre-entry test result from a sample taken 96 hours before departure for approval consideration.
