

# Travel Requirements Brunei Darussalam

- Travel Green List is withdrawn
- All vaccinated travellers are allowed to enter/exit Brunei for non-essential travel
- Entry Travel Pass not required



- Adolescents (ages 12-17) who are Bruneian citizens or residents must be boosted if they wish to exit Brunei

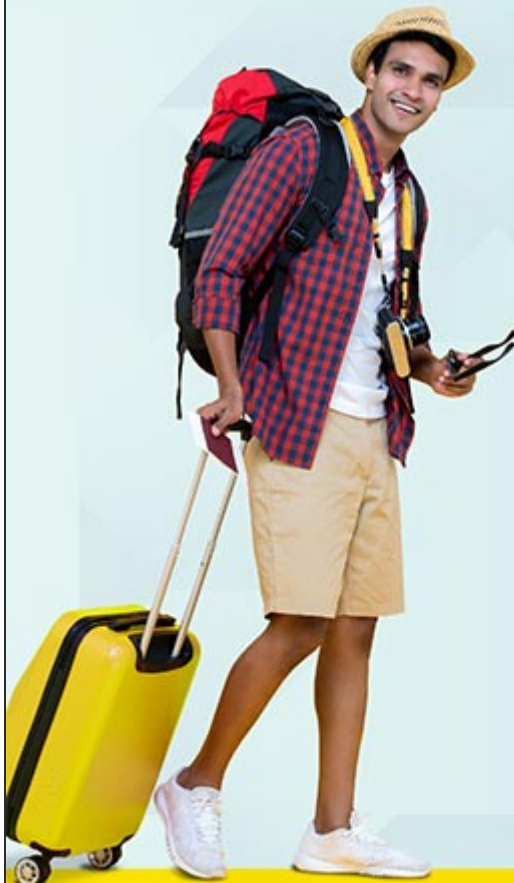
**COVID-19 Test\*\***  
RT-PCR test within 2 days before departure  
OR  
Certified ART within 1 day before departure



**Travel Health Insurance**  
Foreign nationals visiting Brunei for less than 90 days



**E-Health Arrival Declaration Form (ADF)**  
Complete not more than 24 hours before departure at [www.healthinfo.gov.bn/travel](http://www.healthinfo.gov.bn/travel)



## Arrival into Brunei



**RT-PCR Tests**  
Not required

**Fully vaccinated travellers entering Brunei:**

- No longer have to self-isolate
- Perform ART on day of arrival, day 2 and 3 (BND 40.00\* for all 3 kits)

**Unvaccinated travellers can only enter Brunei if:**

- They have proof of a medical exemption
- They take an ART upon arrival and PCR test on Day 3 (BND 100.00\*)
- They undergo self-isolation until they receive their RT-PCR result

**COVID-19 recovered travellers** (must have proof of infection)

- Perform ART upon arrival on Day 1 only (BND 20.00\*)

\*Obtain payment receipt for post arrival COVID-19 test via E-Health ADF

## Transit in Brunei



**Fully vaccinated**



**Next documents on-hand**  
Adhere to any other requirements set by the destination country



**COVID-19 Test\*\***  
RT-PCR test within 2 days before departure OR  
Certified ART within 1 day before departure



**Remain in airport**

Transit travellers are **not allowed** to leave airport regardless of the transit duration

\*\*COVID-19 Recovered travellers who have proof of infection are exempted from this requirement

Should a traveller be tested positive for COVID-19, they will be required to undergo a period of isolation at their hotel accommodation or home residence in compliance with existing health protocols.
