



Important Announcement

As Directed by Ministry of Health and Family welfare, Government of India.

- All International passengers travelling from China, Hong Kong, Japan, South Korea, Singapore and Thailand to India are hereby required to undergo mandatory RTPCR tests before departure, effective from 1st January 2023.
- The Test should have been conducted within 72 hours of undertaking the journey to India.
- 3. Upload the Negative RTPCR report along with self-declaration form on Air Suvihda Portal.
- Passengers from USA, Australia, Canada, Magnolia and New Zealand transitting via South Korea are not required RTPCR test.
- 5. This is in additional to the random 2% tests for all international passengers on the arrival to India.
