Dear Travel Partner,

We would like to inform you that the Ministry of Civil Aviation, in coordination with the Directorate General of Health Services and the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, has relaunched the [Air Suvidha portal](#) for Passenger Health Self-Declaration.

This initiative mandates a Passenger Health Self-Declaration for all international passengers arriving in India, with the objective of strengthening public health surveillance at the different ports of entry.

All international passengers travelling to India are required to complete a Self-Declaration Form (SDF) covering:

- Travel History
- Exposure History
- Related Symptoms

Completion of the SDF enables real-time data sharing with the relevant health and immigration authorities

We request you to inform passengers:

- To complete the SDF online via the [Air Suvidha 2.0 Portal](#) before boarding or during web check-in.
- The form may be submitted up to 24 hours before arrival in India. All details must be filled in accurately.
- Download and carry the completed SDF. On arrival, present it at the International Travel Health Desk or Immigration Counter. No physical paperwork is required on landing.

Note: Failure to present a completed SDF may result in delays at immigration upon arrival.

Advisory:

All passengers are strongly advised to complete the Self-Declaration Form in advance, in the interest of passenger safety and public health.
